“RECOMMENDING TO ADOPT ZARO TRADING AS THE SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE PROVISION OF ADMISSION KITS FOR CALABARZON TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITY”

WHEREAS, the BAC received a Purchase Request from OCD CALABARZON – DRRM Division Chief for the **PROVISION OF ADMISSION KIT FOR THE CALABARZON TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITIES** with the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **THREE HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY FIVE PESOS (P358,865.00) ONLY** which was duly approved by HOPE on **10 May 2021** with funding source from Unprogrammed Appropriations (Bayanihan Act 2) and was downloaded to OCD CALABARZON Regular Fund;

WHEREAS, the BAC Chairperson recommended to convene the Bids and Awards Committee on **02 June 2021** to discuss the mode of procurement to be used for the **PROVISION OF ADMISSION KIT FOR THE CALABARZON TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITIES**;

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation, the BAC agreed to recommend the adoption of **Negotiated Procurement under Emergency Case per Republic Act No. 11494** as the mode of procurement with a reference under **GPPB Resolution No. 18-2020**;

WHEREAS, the BAC received proposal and quotation from three (3) suppliers namely: **ZARO TRADING, MERCURY DRUG CORPORATION** and **WATSONS CALAMBA** and the BAC Chairperson requested to convene the committee on **04 June 2021, 07:00PM** for the opening of their bids;

WHEREAS, upon the opening of their quotation, the BAC received an amount of **Php 326,745.00** from **ZARO TRADING** while **MERCURY DRUG CORPORATION** and **WATSONS CALAMBA** did not open the quotation due to their disqualification;


