**“RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO COSTSAVERS
SUPERMARKET, INC. FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF JANITORIAL
SUPPLIES FOR THE COVID-19 ISOLATION FACILITIES IN REGION 1 (BATCH
2)”**

WHEREAS, on 11 September 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Republic Act (RA) No. 11494 or the “Bayanihan to Recover as One Act (Bayanihan 2)” in view of the continuous health emergency operation against the spread of the Coronavirus Disease – 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, in view of the effectivity of RA 11519, on 08 January 2021, the OCD CO issued OCD Memorandum No. 18, s. 2021 reiterating validity extension of the Republic Act (RA) No. 11494 or the “Bayanihan to Recover as One Act (Bayanihan 2)” likewise extending the validity of the Bayanihan 2 Funds until 30 June 2021;

WHEREAS, on 17 March 2021, the OCD RO-I submitted a formal request to the OCD Central Office (CO) for additional funds in the amount of Forty-Two Million Three Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 42,333,750.00) to continuously support the existing and newly-identified isolation facilities in Region 1;

WHEREAS, on 31 March 2021, the OCD CO approved the request intended to support the COVID-19 isolation facilities in Region 1;

WHEREAS, the Purchase Request (PR) No. 2021-06-0087 of the Operations Section under the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Division of OCD RO-I for the **Supply and Delivery of Janitorial Supplies for the COVID-19 Isolation Facilities in Region 1 (Batch 2)** was approved and submitted on 15 June 2021 (Annex A);

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) was **One Million Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 1,300,000.00)** charged against the RF - Bayanihan Act 2;

WHEREAS, on the same day of request, 15 June 2021, OCD RO-I Regional Director Eugene G. Cabrera, as Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE), approved the Supplemental Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) (Annex B) and the

Emergency Purchase Certificate (EPC) No. 2021-06-0017 (**Annex C**) recommending the adoption of **Alternative Method of Procurement** in accordance with **Negotiated Mode of Procurement - Section 53.2 for Emergency Cases** of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184 for the implementation of the said project;

WHEREAS, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Resolution No. 03-2020 dated 09 March 2020 stipulated that **Alternative Method of Procurement** in accordance with **Negotiated Mode of Procurement under Section 53.2 for Emergency Cases** of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 can be undertaken for *"instances or situations where the foregoing conditions may be applied include the provision of immediate response and initial recovery steps to avoid loss of life, injury, disease and other negative effects on human, physical, mental and social well-being, together with damage to property, destruction of assets, loss of services, social and economic disruption and environmental degradation"*;

WHEREAS, GPPB Resolution No. 03-2020 likewise authorized the HoPE to delegate the BAC or the End-User unit or any other appropriate bureau, committee, support or procuring unit to directly negotiate with a legally, technically, and financially capable supplier, contractor, or consultant for procurement undertaken through any of the allowable instances;

WHEREAS, the same resolution provided for the immediate award of contract to the supplier, contractor or consultant of known legal, financial, and technical capability, by the HoPE, or his duly authorized representative, upon the recommendation of the BAC or the End-User unit or any other appropriate bureau, committee, support or procuring unit;

WHEREAS, the OCD RO-I issued the Request for Quotation (RFQ) No. 2021-06-0071 on 15 June 2021 (**Annex D**);

WHEREAS, the HoPE, with the extended validity of Bayanihan 2, delegated the implementing section to initiate the identification and negotiation with the prospective supplier namely, **COSTSAVERS SUPERMARKET, INC.**, which complied with the technical and financial specifications of the project;

WHEREAS, the implementing section further recommended **COSTSAVERS SUPERMARKET, INC.** as the legally, technically and financially capable supplier for the procurement of the said project;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the Members of the OCD RO-I BAC, by virtue of the functions and responsibilities vested on US by law, indorse the recommendation of the implementing section, hereby RECOMMEND to the HoPE, the immediate award of contract to **COSTSAVERS SUPERMARKET, INC.** for the **Supply and Delivery of**

Janitorial Supplies for the COVID-19 Isolation Facilities in Region 1 (Batch 2) in the amount One Million Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php 1,299,400.00) only;


