This Contract Agreement, made and entered into by and between:

The OFFICE OF CIVIL DEFENSE, a government agency with principal office and postal address at Camp General Emilio Aguinaldo, Quezon City herein represented by its Administrator, USEC. RICARDO B. JALAD, of legal age, Filipino, hereinafter known as the "OCD";

-and-

TELMO SOLUTIONS, a privately owned IT Services agency with business and postal address at 489 Ruby St., Sandy Lane, Fatima, Marasbaras, Brgy. 77, Tacloban City, herein represented by its Proprietor, JOHN KENNETH P. TELMO, of legal age, hereinafter referred to as the "CONSULTANT";

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the OCD engages the services of the CONSULTANT to perform the services herein after referred to and the latter agrees to perform these services for the project "Hiring of Highly Technical Consultant for the Supply, Development, Installation, Configuration, Testing and Delivery of Planning and Budgeting Management Information System (PBMIS)";

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES hereby agree as follows:

1. SERVICES

The CONSULTANT shall perform the services specified in the approved Terms of Reference of the abovementioned project and Request for Quotation (RFQ) No. PDPS-1121-001 which form as integral part of this Contract and shall be referred to as "Services";

2. EXPECTED OUTPUT AND DELIVERABLE

The CONSULTANT shall be responsible for the DEVELOPMENT, INSTALLATION, CONFIGURATION, TESTING and DELIVERY of a Planning and Budgeting Management Information System (PBMIS) which include the following deliverables:

- a. Inception Report;
- b. PBMIS beta releases;
- c. User-acceptance Testing (UAT);
- d. PBMIS Go-Live;
- e. User/Processor Training;
- Comprehensive training on administration, performance tuning, and troubleshooting; and
- Turnover of all project documentations, source codes and other pertinent assets.

The **CONSULTANT**, upon the completion of the project, shall submit five (5) copies of the Completion Report and all final documentation of the project. The authorized OCD personnel shall sign a Certificate of Completion and Certificate of Acceptance of the delivered services for the project.

3. DURATION OF ENGAGEMENT

The Services of the CONSULTANT will be engaged for a period of four (4) months starting from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed (NTP).

4. PAYMENT TERMS

Contract amount: For services rendered pursuant to Annex B (Price Quotation Form) of the Request for Quotation (RFQ) No. PDPS-1121-001, the contract price shall be in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP1,500,000.00) only. The price herein agreed shall not be subject to any increase or upward adjustment for any reason or cause whatsoever during the duration of the contract.
